Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 17th October, 1906.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The total amounts paid in each case to the owners of the Kinloch and Morice Estates; (2) the total annual amounts in each case to be collected by way of rent when all allotments are disposed of; (3) the amount which each estate has been loaded with for roading or any other purpose."—(Mr. RHODES.)
