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The following are some of the principal subjects to be discussed at the forthcoming Colonial Conference to be held in London next year:—

- Imperial Council.
- Preferential trade.
- Reciprocity with regard to the admission of colonial barristers to practice within the British dominions.
- Naturalisation.
- Defence.
- Islands of the Pacific.
- Reservation of Bills.
- Legislation—power of the colonies to make reciprocal-tariff treaties with one another.
