FISH EXPORTED AND BONUS PAID.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 19th September, 1906.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The quantity and value of fish exported from this colony each year whilst the bonus for export was in operation, the amount of bonus paid to be also stated; and (2) the quantity and value of fish exported each year since the bonus was discontinued."—(Mr. STALLWORTHY).
