CORONERS' INQUESTS

(RETURNS RELATIVE TO) IN AUCKLAND, WELLINGTON, CHRISTCHURCH, AND DUNEDIN.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 3rd October, 1906.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The number of inquests held during the two years ending the 30th June, 1906, by the Coroners of the four large centres—viz., Cities of Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, Dunedin—and the adjacent boroughs and suburbs of each city; (2) the number of inquests held by each Coroner separately; (3) the number of post-mortems ordered by each Coroner, and the total cost of such post-mortems, in each such centre; (4) the cost, including jury fees, incurred by each Coroner in holding such inquests."
