MEDICAL OFFICER'S REPORT.

Ponsonby Road, 25th March, 1907. DEAR SIR,

I have the honour to report, for the information of the Trustees, upon the health of the above Institution. There has been the usual amount of simple ailments, but which is always small in quantity. Two cases gave some cause for anxiety. One boy showed signs of acute rheumatism, but after his removal to the hospital developed into more serious condition of tuberculosis and disease of the bone of leg. He was extremely ill for some time, but has, I believe, since improved considerably. The other case was one of pneumonia: this boy also was removed to the hospital and has since recovered to the hospital, and has since recovered.
