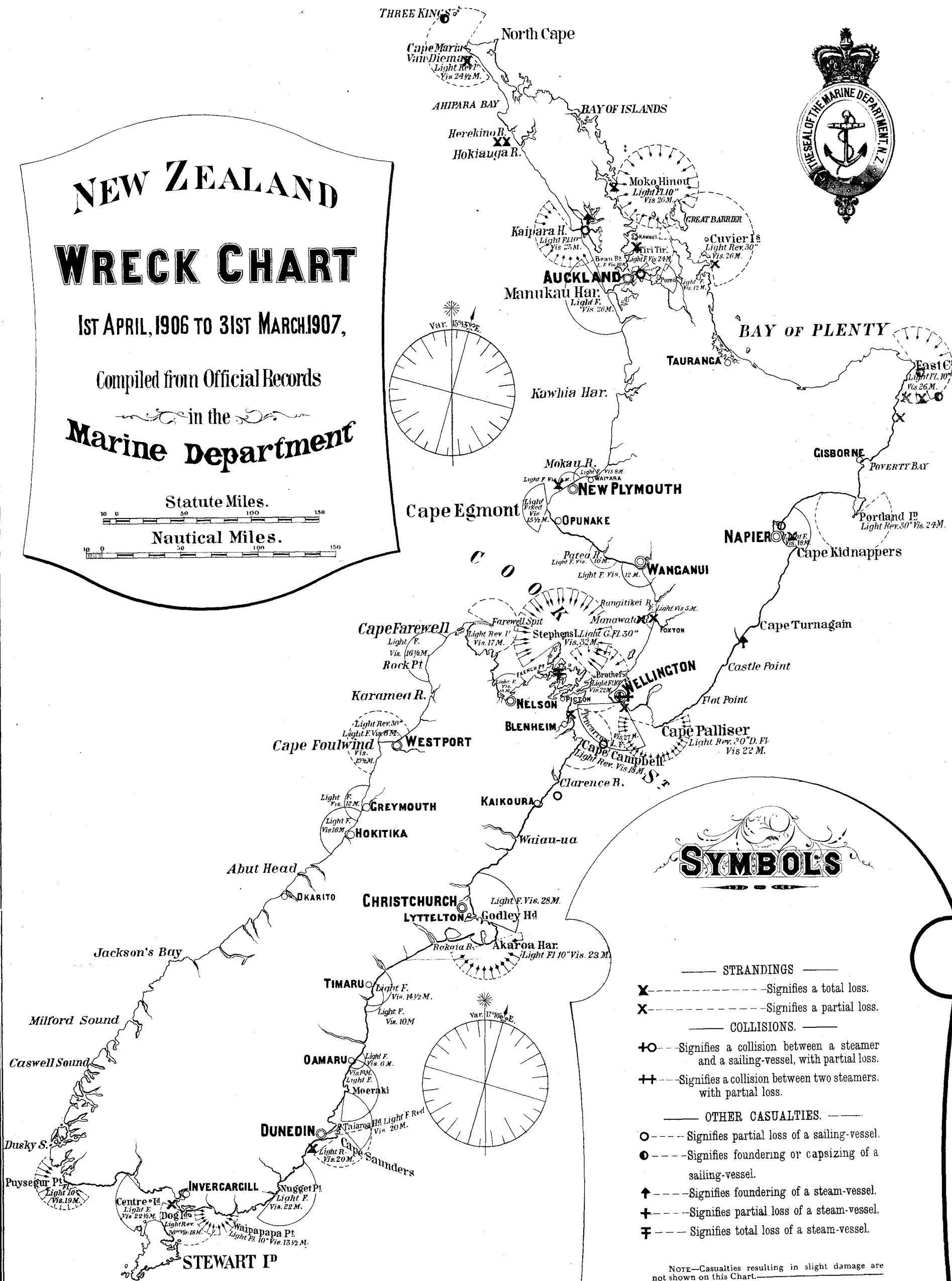
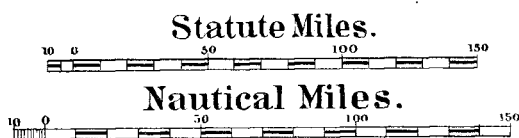


NEW ZEALAND WRECK CHART
