

The following table (L1) gives the customary information of the attendance at the schools and the staff employed.

The total number of pupils on the rolls of secondary schools in the last term or quarter of the year was 2,528 boys and 1,668 girls, as against 2,528 boys and 1,742 girls at the end of 1906.
