ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings, at Wellington, this fourth day of February, 1908.

The Right Honourable Sir J. G. Ward, K.C.M.G., Presiding in Council.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by "The Explosives Act, 1882," "The Explosives Act Amendment Act, 1897," and "The Sale of Explosives Act, 1906," and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order that, on and after the first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and eight, the following regulation shall take effect:—
