Table G2 shows the total income from education reserves for the ten years, 1899-1908, and the cost of administration by the School Commissioners for the same period. In comparing these figures with those for 1898–1907, published in last year's report, it will be seen that the total income amounted in the last ten years to £585,644, as against £572,119 for 1898–1907, an increase of £13,525. The percentage of cost of administration shows a slight decrease, 6.49, as compared with 6.76. It may be noted, however, that in Westland more than a quarter of the total income for the last ten years has been absorbed by the expenses of administration.
