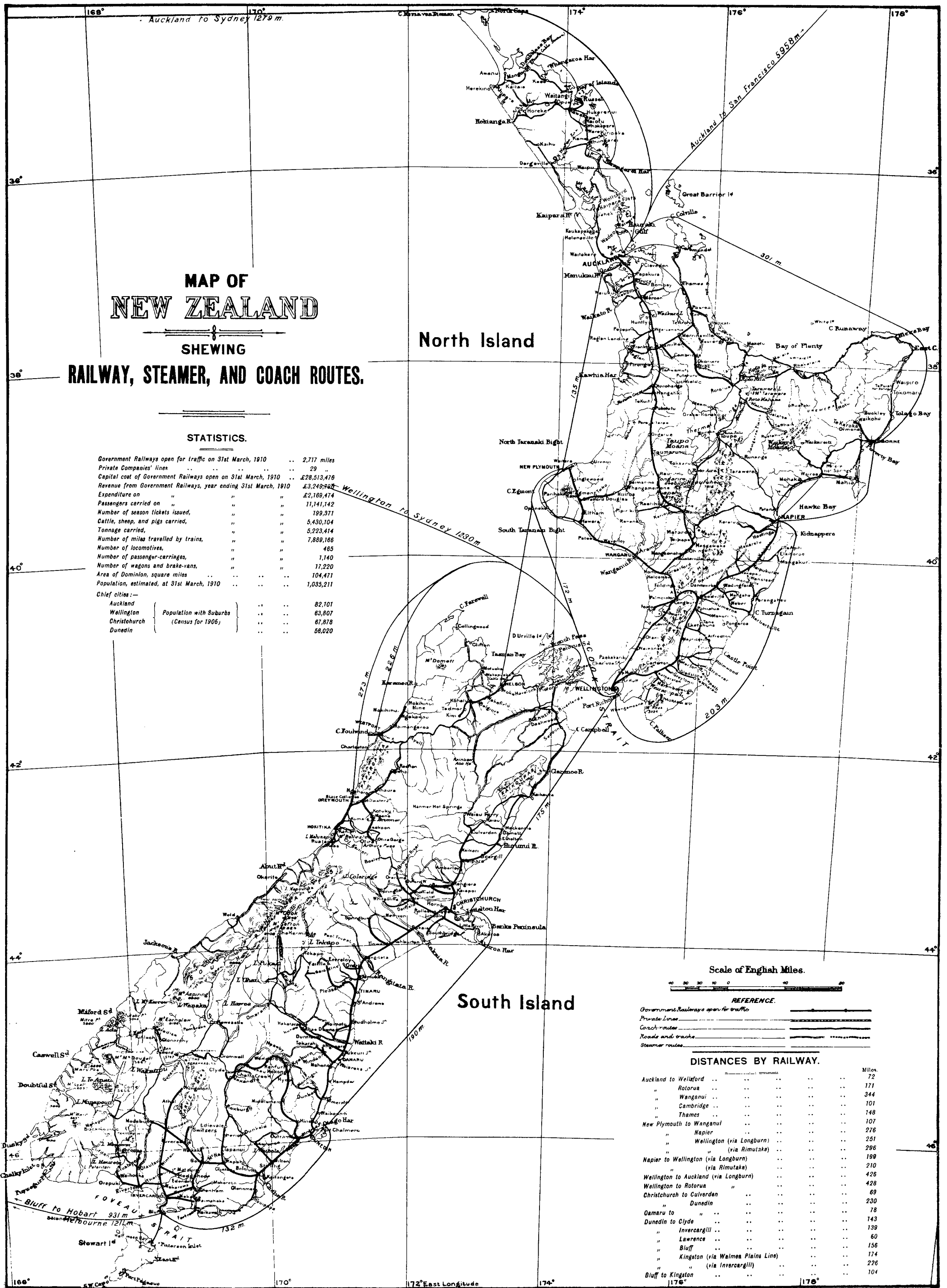


MAP OF NEW ZEALAND
