MEDICAL ATTENDANCE ON NATIVES IN SOUTH ISLAND

(Dr. POMARE'S REPORT ON).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 6th July, 1910.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House Dr. Pomare's recent report upon the medical wants of the South Island Maoris, showing—(1) The medical attendance at the present time provided by the Government for the Maori residents of the several kaingas throughout the South Island, commencing at Kaikoura, and extending southwards to Kawhakaputaputa, and including Stewart Island and Ruapuke Island; (2) the amount per annum which has been expended by the Government in medicines and subsidies to doctors in the case of each of the said kaingas respectively during the past five years; and (3) the names of the kaingas throughout the said districts from which Government medical assistance has now been withdrawn."—(Mr. Parata.)
