Several cases of alleged breach of the regulation as to labelling were inquired into, notably as to the newly issued regulations as to jam. In the majority of cases it was found that the labels complained of were the remains of old stock in retail shops. In one case a misleading statement on a label in regard to the substance known as “egg-powder” was dealt with, and the manufacturer warned.
