The decrease in production above recorded is confined to the mines within the boroughs of Waihi and Thames, and to the Province of Otago; the quartz-mines of Ohinemuri have slightly increased their annual production, and those of the west coast of the South Island have maintained their position.

The following is a statement showing the tons of ore treated, the value of bullion produced, and the amount of dividends paid by quartz-mining companies in each of the inspection districts during the years 1910 and 1911.
