Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The total area of endowment lands actually under lease on the 1st September, 1913, in each provincial district; (2) the maximum area leased to any one individual leaseholder; (3) the minimum area leased to any one individual leaseholder; and (4) the total area of endowment lands unleased in each provincial district."—(Sir W. C. BUCHANAN.)
