" 2	J. Roberts	Injured fingers	Timaru	Got his finger jammed between a lump of coal and a basket.
" 2	G. Bentley	Injured finger	Timaru	Got his finger jammed between a sling of rails and a stanchion.
" 3	J. Cootes	Injured head and shoulder	Wellington	Whilst driving winch a block fell from aloft on to his head.
" 4	G. Watson	Injured head and shoulder	Greymouth	Got his finger cut by a piece of coal.
" 10	E. Gale	Injured head and shoulder	Greymouth	Jammed his finger in door of railway-wagon.
" 14	W. Harper	Injured foot	Lyttelton	He trod on a nail which pierced his foot.

" 10	A. O'Connor	Killed	Wanganui	Crushed against coamings by sling of cargo. Verdict: Accident resulted from accident at winch while cargo being removed from hold.
" 16	William Pollard	Concussion and injured head	Wellington	He fell into bunker.
" 29	S. Grunnell	Injured head	Wellington	Whilst trucking coal, a railway-engine struck the staging and knocked him off.
" 29	H. Colthorpe	Injured arm	Dunedin	Whilst loading cargo he injured his arm.
Aug. 2	T. Mathieson	Injured fingers	Greymouth	He was struck by wagon-chains.
" 6	H. Miled	Internal injuries	Wellington	He was knocked off staging into a coal-hulk.
" 12	R. Mason	Strained arm	Greymouth	He had his arm jerked by yard-rope.
" 16	J. P. Desmond	Injured head	Greymouth	A piece of timber fell from a sling and struck his head.
" 16	B. Hands	Injured hand	Greymouth	Got his hand jammed between a sling of timber and the hatch-coamings.
" 19	F. Rosel	Injured hand	Greymouth	Jammed on gin-block.
" 26	J. McGinley	Injured leg	Greymouth	Was struck by capstan-rope.
" 30	P. Nelson	Injured foot	Greymouth	Fore-and-aft beam fell on his foot.
Sept. 2	A. Nicolson	Crushed foot	Bluff	Some timber fell on his foot.
" 5	F. Gilmore	Injured fingers	Wellington	Got his fingers jammed by a piece of timber against coamings.
" 16	R. Lloyd	Killed	Wellington	Verdict: "Killed by derrick falling on him; no blame attachable to any one."
" 18	R. McGimpsey	Bruised	New Plymouth	Some timber fell out of a sling and struck him.
" 26	D. McKenzie	Injured leg	Timaru	Whilst unloading potatoes a tier fell on his leg.
