ORDERS OF REFERENCE.

Extracts from the Journals of the House of Representatives.

FRIDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF JULY, 1914.

Ordered, "That Standing Order No. 219 be suspended, and that a Goldfields and Mines Committee be appointed, consisting of twelve members, to whom shall be referred all matters relating to mining, and all Bills relating to mines; with power to call for persons and papers; three to be a quorum: the Committee to consist of Mr. R. F. Bollard, Sir W. C. Buchanan, Mr. Colvin, Mr. Lee, Hon. Mr. McKenzie, Mr. Poland, Mr. T. W. Rhodes, Mr. Scott, Mr. Seddon, Mr. G. M. Thomson, Mr. Webb, and the mover."—(Hon. Mr. FRASER.)

Ordered, "That all petitions not finally dealt with during session 1913 stand referred to the same Committees as they were referred to during the said session."—(Hon. Mr. MASSEY.)

THURSDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1914.

Ordered, "That the petition of J. S. Fawcett and others be referred direct to the Goldfields and Mines Committee."—(Hon. Mr. FRASER.)

THURSDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF OCTOBER, 1914.

Ordered, "That the Coal-mines Amendment Bill be referred to the Goldfields and Mines Committee."—(Hon. Mr. FRASER.)

Ordered, "That the Mining Amendment Bill be referred to the Goldfields and Mines Committee."—(Hon. Mr. FRASER.)

TUESDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1914.
