ORDERS OF REFERENCE.

Extracts from the Journals of the House of Representatives.

FRIDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF JULY, 1914.

Ordered. "That a Committee be appointed, consisting of ten members, to examine and report upon questions relating to the railways; with power to call for persons and papers, three to be a quorum: the Committee to consist of Mr. Buick, Mr. Dickson, Mr. Hine, Hon. Mr. Millar, Mr. Myers, Mr. Sidey, Mr. Sykes, Mr. Veitch, Mr. Witty, and the mover."—(Hon. Mr. HERRIES.)

Ordered. "That all petitions not finally dealt with during session 1913 stand referred to the same Committees as they were referred to during the said session."—(Right Hon. Mr. MASSEY.)

WEDNESDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1914.

Ordered. "That the petition of Mary Davidson be referred direct to the Railways Committee."—(Mr. DICKSON.)
