An examination of the salaries-list shows that 871 male teachers, representing 53.5 per cent. of the number of male teachers in primary schools, receive a salary of £200 per annum or over. If the schools with an average attendance of 15 or less are excluded, the percentage rises to 58.2. In England 17.1 per cent. of certificated male teachers receive a salary of £200 per annum or over.
