## Drunkenness.

There has been an increase of 1,482 in the number of persons prosecuted for drunkenness during the year as compared with the previous year.

From the following table it will be observed that 39.64 per cent. of the males and 66.55 per cent. of the females had previous convictions recorded against them, and 7.1 per cent. of the males were not permanent residents in the Dominion:—
