EXPEDITIONARY FORCE.

RETURN SHOWING NUMBER OF MEN REGISTERED IN EACH MILITARY DISTRICT, AND
NUMBER PASSED AND GONE INTO CAMP.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 1st June, 1916.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing the number of men that have enlisted in the different provincial districts in the Dominion, and the number that have been passed by the different doctors and gone into camp."—(Mr. OKEY.)
