REPORT.

THE Board has the honour to submit the following report upon the transactions in connection with the Public Service Superannuation Fund.

The Revenue Account, balance-sheet, and statements regarding membership and retiring and

other allowances will be found appended.

The Board.—By the Amendment Act of last session the Government Insurance Commissioner, the State Advances Superintendent, the Secretary of the Post and Telegraph Department, and the Valuer-General are appointed ϵx officio members of the Board, in place of the members previously nominated by the Government. Under the above provision H. J. H. Blow, Esq., I.S.O., ceases to be a member of the Board.

Retiring and other Allowances. — Pensions for £11,562 6s. per annum were granted during the year, as follows: For age or length of service, £8,271 15s. per annum to sixty-eight members (sixty-four male and four female members); for medical unfitness for duty, £1,345 11s. to twenty members (nineteen male and one female member); to widows and children of deceased members, £918 per annum to fifty-one widows, and £1,027 per annum to seventy-nine children.

The largest retiring-allowance granted during the year to a contributor was £454 3s. and the smallest £1 13s. per annum, while the average was £109 5s. 9d.
