FINAL REPORT.

I HAVE the honour to report that the Native Affairs Committee held its final meeting this morning.

During the session the Committee met on 34 occasions, with an average attendance of 9 at each meeting.

Including 119 brought forward from last session, the Committee had before it 194 petitions. Of these, 116 were considered and reported upon, and the remaining 78 are held over for consideration next session.

Upon 24 the Committee reported favourably, upon 82 it had no recommendation to make, and 10 were withdrawn.

The Native Land Amendment and Native Land Claims Adjustment Bill, and clauses 41 and 49 of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies Empowering Bill were referred to the Committee, and were duly considered and reported upon.

Five parliamentary papers were referred to the Committee, and were duly considered and reported upon.

The total number of reports presented to the House was 120.

RIPOATA WHAKAMUTUNGA.

KEI te whai honore ahau ki te ripoata i tu te huihuinga whakamutunga o te Komiti mo nga mea Maori i te ata nei.

I roto i tenei tuunga o te Paremete a 34 nga huihuinga o te Komiti, a ki te aronga e rite ana e 9 nga mema i tae mai ki ia huihuinga kotahi o te Komiti.

Hui atu ki nga mea 119 i tae mai i tera tuunga o te Paremete, 194 nga pitihana i takoto ki te aroaro o te Komiti. O roto i ena 116 nga mea i whiriwhiria a i ripoatatia hoki, a ko nga mea e 78 e toe ana kua waiho atu mo tenei tuunga o te Paremete o haere mai nei.

I runga i nga mea e 24 i puta he ripoata tautoko ma te Komiti, a i runga i nga mea e 82 kaore kau he kupu tohutohu a te Komiti, a 10 nga mea i unuhia.

Ko nga Pire e whai ake nei i tukua mai ki te Komiti, i ata whiriwhiria, a i ripoatatia hoki, ara : Pire Whakatikatika Ture Whenua Maori, Whakariterite Kereme Whenua Maori me tekiona 41 me 49 o te Pire Tuku Rahui me era atu Whenua, Whakamana hoki i nga Ropu Whakahaere mo te Katoa.

E rima nga Pukapuka Paremete i tukua mai ki a te Komiti, i ata niuia, a i ripoatatia hoki.

Hui katoa nga ripoata i tukua atu ki te Whare 120.
