SLY-GROG SELLING IN KING-COUNTRY

(RETURN RELATIVE TO).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 11th September, 1917.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The number of convictions recorded during the past five years for sly-grog selling in the various Courts in the Rohe Potae, otherwise known as the King-country; (2) the amount received in fines during the same period; and (3) the number of applications recorded in the same period at the various Courts for supplies of liquor sent into the district."—(Mr. JENNINGS.)

RETURN.

- (1.) Number of convictions recorded during the past five years (ended 31st August, 1917) for sly-grog selling in the various Courts in the Rohe Potae, otherwise known as the King-country: 121.
- (2.) Amount received in fines during the same period: £1,997 10s. 8d.
- (3.) Number of applications recorded during the same period at the various Courts for supplies of liquor sent into the district: 95,510.
