All the above leases are for the term of twenty-one years from the dates shown, and give lessees the right of renewal for a further term of twenty-one years, with the exception of the Tawapata South No. 1 and Whaitiri No. 2 blocks. The rentals for such further term are to be fixed by arbitration. All the leases with the exception of those for Whangawehi Nos. 1B and 1c and Whaitiri No. 2 provide for compensation for improvements effected by lessees.
