## Conclusion.

I wish here to express the deepest sympathy with the relatives and friends of those officers of the Department who have laid down their lives in the glorious fight for freedom, and to congratulate those who have, up to the present, come through the manifold dangers of the war. And, finally, I desire most heartily to thank the members of the staff who, being themselves unable to render military service, have throughout this most trying year assisted to keep the work of the Department as nearly as possible at the high level the country now expects of it.
