REPORT.

SECTION I.—GENERAL.

1. Change of Command.

Major-General Sir A. W. Robin, K.C.M.G., C.B. (b), relinquished the appointment of General Officer Commanding New Zealand Military Forces as from the 10th December, 1919, on which date I assumed command.

2. STAFF ORGANIZATION.

With the appointment of Brigadier-General G. S. Richardson, C.B., C.M.G., C.B.E., as Officer in Command Administration the appointments of Adjutant-General and Quartermaster-General and a number of "Directorates" were abolished. In consequence of these changes it was decided to discontinue the cumbersome designations of "Assistant Quartermaster-General," "Assistant Adjutant-General," &c., and to reorganize the Staff into one General Staff—officers being graded as Staff Captains, Staff Majors, &c., according to their rank.
