Since the inauguration of the fund 590 beneficiaries have, however, died, and 16 members who had been placed on the fund as "medically unfit" resumed duty. The fund was relieved of an annual liability of £43,518 9s. 11d. in respect to these 606 members; 462 children have reached the age of fourteen years, 14 children have died, 81 widows remarried, 44 widows died; lessening the liability of the fund by an additional £8,438 per annum. There were 2,005 persons actually on the fund at the 31st March, 1921, involving an annual liability of £129,999 18s. 6d.
