UNEXHAUSTED LOAN AUTHORITIES

POSSESSED BY THE GOVERNMENT AS AT THE 1st DECEMBER, 1921 (RETURN OF).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 20th December, 1921.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The amount and nature of unexhausted loan authorities possessed by the Government as at the 1st December, 1921; and (2) (a) the charges and expenses, (b) cost per cent. of raising loans, and (c) from what source or sources loan or renewal loans were obtained in respect of each of the following loans: Lands Improvement and Native Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (due 30th September, 1920, renewed to 30th September, 1925), £341,000; Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908 (due 1st January, 1921, renewed to 1st January, 1926), £785,000; Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908 (due 1st March, 1921, renewed to 1st March, 1926), £370,000; Mining Amendment Act, 1913 (due 1st May, 1920, renewed to 1st May, 1925), £4,500; Native Land Amendment Act, 1913 (due 1st April, 1920, renewed to 1st April, 1925), £250,000; Post and Telegraph Act, 1908 (due 1st July, 1920, renewed to 1st July, 1925), £200,000; Public Revenues Amendment Act, 1915, section 5 (due 1st February, 1921, renewed to 1st February, 1926), £1,700,000; Railways Improvement Authorization Act, 1914 (due 1st August, 1920, renewed to 1st August, 1925), £140,000; Railways Improvement Authorization Act, 1914 (due 1st February, 1921, renewed to 1st February, 1926), £240,000; Rangitaiki Land Drainage Amendment Acts, 1913–14 (due 1st September, 1920, renewed to 1st September, 1925), £19,000; Wellington and Manawatu Railway Purchase Act, 1908 (due 1st March, 1920, renewed to 1st March, 1926), £499,700."—(Hon.
