The amounts shown in the lists attached to the balance-sheets are those actually disbursed during the year, and do not represent the total annual allowances granted by the Board to the 31st March, 1922, which were,—

Since the inauguration of the fund 636 beneficiaries have, however, died, and 17 members who had been placed on the fund as "medically unfit" resumed duty. The fund was relieved of an annual liability of £47,614 4s. 4d. in respect to these 653 members; 502 children have reached the age of fourteen years, 14 children have died, 94 widows remarried, 50 widows died; lessening the liability of the fund by an additional £9,300 per annum. There were 2,094 persons actually on the fund at the 31st March, 1922, involving an annual liability of £148,092 6s. 1d.
