Elsewhere in the islands travelling has to be done on foot, on horseback, or by boat.

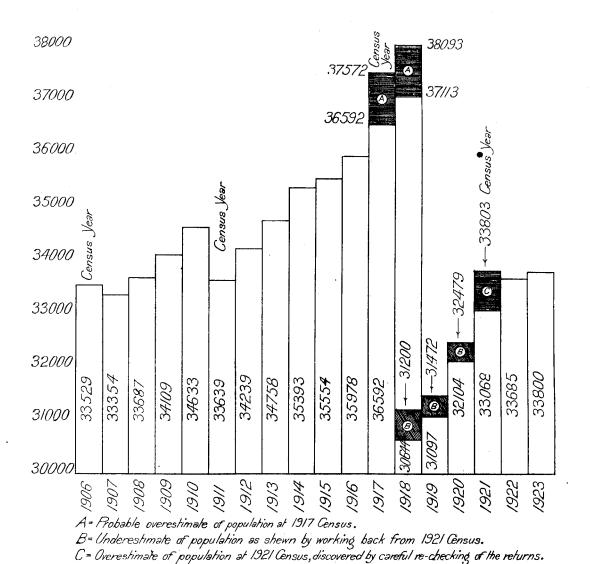


Fig. 15.—Graph showing Native population of Western Samoa, 1906-23.
