S. Dickson, Mr. Glenn, Mr. McIlvride, Mr. Munro, Mr. Nash, Mr. J. C. Rolleston, Mr. Smith, Mr. Sykes, Mr. Witty, and the mover."—(Hon. Mr. COATES.)

Ordered, "That all petitions not finally dealt with during the session of 1923 be again referred to the same Committee as they were referred to during the said session."—(Right Hon. Mr. Massex.)

TUESDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1924.

Ordered, "That the petition of James Wall and others be referred back to the Railways Committee for further consideration."—(Mr. Field.)
