

The "Josephine," which hauled the First Train on the Port Chalmers Dunedin Line, 18th September, 1872.

The "Josephine" was built by the Vulcan Foundry Company at Newton-le-Willows, England. Cylinders, 18 in. by 10 in.; wheels diameter, 3 ft. 9 in.; heating-surface, 829 sq. ft.; water capacity, 800 gallons. Weight in working-trim, 26 tons.

The "Josephine" was exhibited at the New Zealand and South Seas Exhibition.
