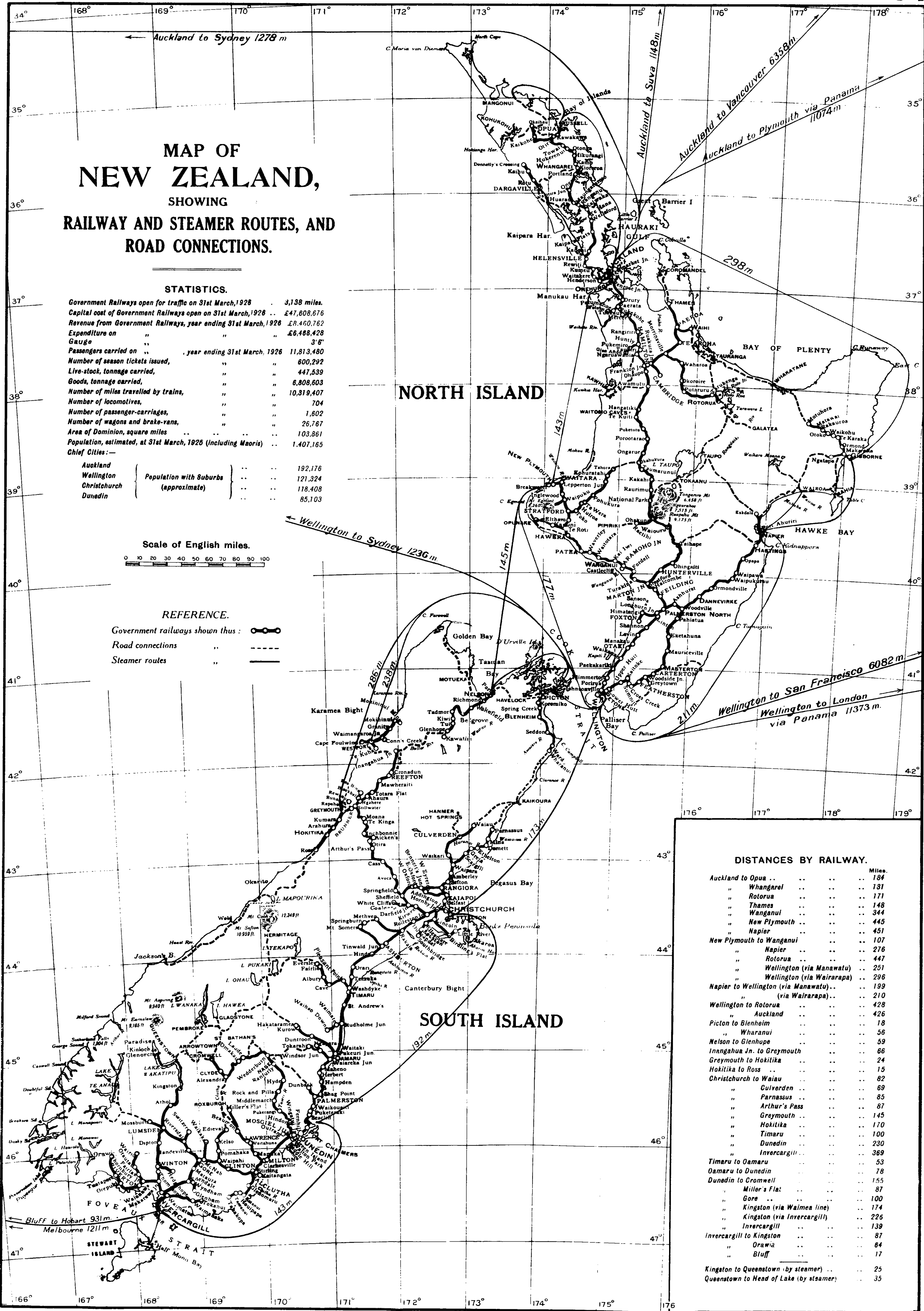




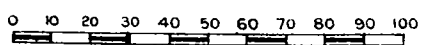
MAP OF NEW ZEALAND,
