(RETURN OF NUMBER OF) ENTERING NEW ZEALAND DURING PAST FIVE YEARS.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 10th August, 1926.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The number of immigrants that have entered this country during the past five years; (2) the number of these immigrants that have settled in the North Island; and (3) the number that have settled in the South Island."—(Mr. HOWARD.)

N.B.—The period during which the 37,103 (assisted) immigrants arrived is 1st April, 1921, to 31st March, 1926.

 - (2) The number of immigrants who have arrived in New Zealand during the year 1936, and who have been granted permanent status.
 - (3) The number of immigrants who have arrived in New Zealand during the year 1936, and who have been granted temporary status.
- N.B.—The period during which the above information was collected was from 1st January to 31st December, 1936.
