PLATE 1. Cross-sections of Wood.




Fig. 1.—Cross-section of Tawa (Beilschmiedia hiva).—The slightly darkened outer zone is an indication of slight ap-stain.




Fig. 41. Cross-section of Ansignis Pine (Pinus radium). The pith and sapstain are clearly defined.
