
PLATE 6. Groundwood Pulps. \times 15.






Fig. IV.—Tawa Groundwood Pulp. Grinder-run No. 15. Classification: Below standard No. 4.





FIG. III.—Tawa Groundwood Pulp. Grinder-run No. 10. Classification: Below standard No. 4.






