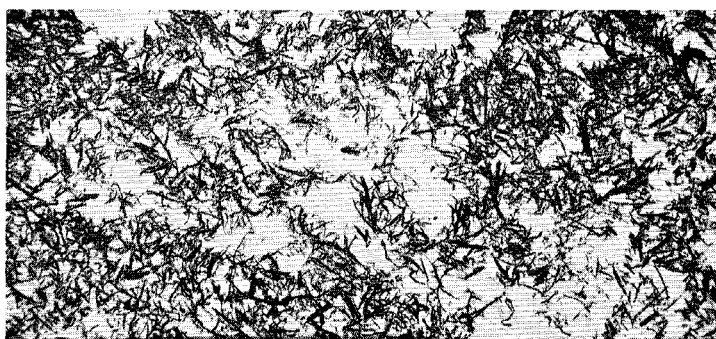


FIG. IV.—Tawa Groundwood Pulp.

Below standard No. 4.

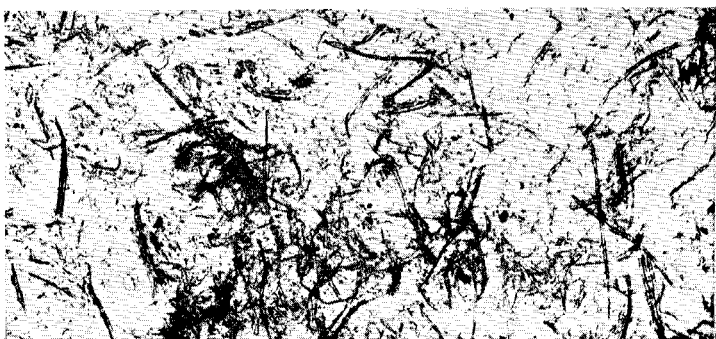


FIG. II.—Insignis-pine Groundwood
