CRIMINAL STATISTICS.

The criminal statistics (Appendix A) deal with offences reported to the police during the year ended 31st December last, and show an aggregate net increase of 529 on the figures of 1926. The proportion of offences to the population was 2.21 per cent., as against 2.19 the previous year.

The principal increases during the year appear under the following headings, viz. :-
