1. Expenditure under the New Plymouth Endowment Act, 1874, totalling £2,976 8s. 10d., should, in the opinion of the Audit Office, be included in the Revenue Account and shown as a charge against rents.

2. Capital Account is overstated (a) by the total amount of loading for roads, &c., (b) by £2,000 balance of

principal unpaid for the purchase of lands in Stewart Island.

3. Separate capital liability bearing interest and sinking fund charges is not shown for expenditure in Crown lands under the Maori Land Settlement Act, 1905.
