


VICKERS "WELLINGTON I."

This twin-engined bomber (Pegasus engines), following the "Wellesley," is the latest type to be built on the patented principle of Vickers "geodetic" construction. Thirty aircraft of this type have been ordered for the two Bomber Squadrons which are being provided under the Government's Air Defence Programme.



Airspeed "Oxford."

The "Oxford," powered with two Armstrong Siddeley Cheetah X motors, is the latest aircraft designed for advanced training. Five of these aircraft have been obtained for New Zealand off the first contract, and two have recently been delivered.
