Special Investigations into Obstetrical Problems.

Thanks to the great interest taken by the staff of these hospitals into problems concerning

obstetrics, much valuable clinical research work is being undertaken.

In 1937 a special investigation was made into the treatment of toxemias of pregnancy by progesterone, and during the past year each of these hospitals has been active in investigating the best method of relieving the pains of labour.
