ORDER OF REFERENCE.

FRIDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF JULY, 1939.

Ordered, "That a Select Committee be appointed, consisting of ten members, to examine into and report upon such questions relating to the public accounts as may be referred to it by the House or the Government, and also into all matters relating to the finances of the Dominion which the Government may refer to it: the Committee to consist of the Right Hon. Mr. Coates, Mr. Dickie, Mr. Lee, Mr. McCombs, Dr. McMillan, Mr. Polson, Mr. Robertson, Mr. Thorn, Mr. Wilkinson, and the Mover."—(Hon. Mr. FRASER, for Hon. Mr. NASL.)
