The main items imported are as follows: Tobacco (10,556 lb.), drapery, hardware, iron and steel, benzine (238,050 gallons), and kerosene (66,829 gallons), butter, preserved fish, tinned meats, rice, sugar, provisions, soap, timber (1,176,795 superficial feet), motor-vehicle parts.
